Detailed information on routes to major universities.

- **ELG (International School of Management) and ESIC (Business & Marketing School):** Hop on bus 4 for a quick 49-minute ride.
- **University of Law:** Reach your destination in approximately 35 minutes by taking bus 4.
- **University of Pharmacy:** Take bus U3 and you'll be there in 50 minutes. You can also combine buses number 4 and then 8, this way you will be there in 45 minutes.
- **University of Economics and Management:** Choosing the same bus combination you use for University of Pharmacy, you can be there in around 50 minutes.

How to get to the city center

- The quickest way is to take the metro from "Parque Tecnológico" station, which is very close to the residence. From there, just get off at the "Recogidas" stop. Once there, you can walk along Calle Recogidas, one of the city's main shopping streets, full of stores and cafés.
- Another option is to use the bus. Line 4 takes you directly to the "Puerta Real" area. From there, you can easily access the most popular parts of Granada.

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An app to track bus timings.

- Download [Granada Bus App](#). Use this helpful app to track bus timings. For the best route planning, check out Google Maps based on your preferences.

How to get a card for the public transport.

- [Points of sale](#): Clicking [here](#) you will find the different points of sale where you can buy the public transport card of Granada, which will allow you to use the metro and the bus.
- You can top up the card starting from €5 in the points of sale, inside the bus with the bus driver and in the metro stops.
- Once you get the card, you can use it for your own travels and the ones that accompany you, you don't need a different card for each one.

The university card.

- If you are enrolled at the University of Granada, you will have a [university card](#) that identifies you ([TUI](#)). You can recharge this card to use it on public transport and a student discount will be applied.
- To get more discounts, ask in establishments such as restaurants, shops and museums showing the TUI.
